I **am** happy. You **are** happy. She **is** happy.
I **am not** happy. You **aren't** happy. She **isn't** happy.
Am I happy? **Are** you happy? **Is** she happy?



„to be”

You **have got** a cat. He **has got** a cat.
You **haven't got** a cat. He **hasn't got** a cat.
Have you **got** a cat? **Has** he **got** a cat?



„have got”

You **like** cars. She **likes** cars.
You **don't like** cars. She **doesn't like** cars.
Do you **like** cars? **Does** she **like** cars?



Present Simple

I **am learning** now. You **are learning** now. She **is learning** now.
I **am not learning** now. You **aren't learning** now. She **isn't learning** now.
Am I **learning** now? **Are** you **learning** now? **Is** she **learning** now?



Present
Continuous

She **started** a course last month. She **took** a day off yesterday.
She **didn't start** a course last month. She **didn't take** a day off yesterday.
Did she **start** a course last month? **Did** she **take** a day off yesterday?



Past Simple

You **have been** to China. She **has been** to China.
You **haven't been** to China. She **hasn't been** to China.
Have you **been** to China? **Has** she **been** to China?



Present
Perfect

You **will help** him.
You **won't help** him.
Will you **help** him?



Future Simple

Am Are Is	I you/we/they he/she/it	<i>going to</i> + verb	OBJECT	?	„to be going to”
-----------------	-------------------------------	---------------------------	--------	---	------------------

I am going to get a job. You are going to get a job. She is going to get a job.
I'm not going to get a job. You aren't going to get a job. She isn't going to get a job.
Am I going to get a job? Are you going to get a job? Is she going to get a job?
